Question 1: Is there any way to extend this bid date?

Answer 1: Yes, the bid opening date will be extended by two weeks to November 13, 2025.

Question 2 Does the MWBE Utilization Plan need to be submitted with the bid?

Answer 2: The list of items required to be submitted with the bid are in section 8.10 of the Instruction to Bidders. The MWBE Utilization Plan is not required to be submitted during the bid process but will need to be filled out and approved prior to executing the contract. The low bidder is required to have made good faith efforts in contacting MWBE firms to meet the MWBE goals of the project.
