LOCAL IAW NO. 1 OF 1934.

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Sub-division B of Section 2 of Local Law No. 5 of 1925, Local Law No. 2 of 1931, and Local Law No. 2 of 1933, providing for an increase of the salary of the City Poor Doctor from \$800.00 to \$1200.00 per annum.

BE IT EMACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, N.Y., that Sub-division B of Section 2 of Local Law No. 5 of 1925, Local Law No. 2 of 1931, and Local Law No. 2 of 1933, be superceded by the following:

A City Poor Doctor who shall be a competent physician and whose duty it shall be, under the direction of the Commissioner of Public Welfare, to visit at their places of abode such of the poor of the city as may be ill, and give medical attention and care to the same as their condition shall require. The term of office of the city poor doctor shall be two years, and he shall hold office until the appointment of his successor. He shall receive an annual salary of not to exceed \$1200.00, payable out of the General Fund.

This Local Law shall take effect February 16, 1934.

On roll call Aldermen Holland, McMillan, Raymond, Light, Frederick and Shay voted in the affirmative. No one in the negative. CARRIED.

The foregoing Local Law is hereby approved after Public Hearing held this 13th day of February, 1934.
