ENTITLED A LOCAL LAW TO ADOPT A SYSTEM OF PERMANENT PERSONAL REGISTRATION, SET FORTH IN ARTICLE 15 OF THE ELECTION LAW.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, NEW YORK, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City of Plattsburgh does hereby elect to adopt, and hereby does adopt for the purpose of the registration of voters for elections within the City of Plattsburgh, the system of Permanent Personal Registration set forth in Article 15 of the Election Law.

SECTION 2: THIS LOCAL LAW SHALL TAKE EFFECT AFTER PUBLIC HEARING AND APPROVAL BY THE MAYOR.

ON ROLL CALL, ALDERMEN HOLLAND, BRAULT, GIOIOSA, JABAUT, CORODIMAS AND FLYNN VOTED IN THE AFFIRMATIVE; NO ONE IN THE NEGATIVE, CARRIED.
