1. Terms. The following terms have the following meanings as used within this ordinance:

"Minor opening" means the removal of less than thirty six feet of street paving either along the length, or across the width of the street.

"Major opening" means the removal of thirty six feet or more of street paving either along the length, or across the width of the street.

2. <u>Permit Requirement.</u> No person shall excavate or remove the surface of any street, sidewalk, or unimproved City street or right of way without first obtaining a street and sidewalk opening permit.

- 3. Authority to Issue Permits. The Building Inspector shall have the authority to issue street and sidewalk opening permits for minor openings. The City Engineer shall have the authority to issue street and sidewalk opening permits for major openings. The Building Inspector and City Engineer shall have the authority to impose such permit conditions as in their judgment are necessary to promote public safety, including the authority to specify the design, method of construction and materials used in making required improvements, temporary covers and barricades.
- 4. <u>Permit Requirements.</u> In addition to such conditions as may be imposed by the Building Inspector and City Engineer, the following requirements shall apply:
  - 4.1 When a sidewalk or curb section is removed or damaged, it shall be replaced with new materials and shall not be patched or otherwise repaired.
  - 4.2 When a street is opened under a minor opening permit, that area of the street that is disturbed, damaged or removed shall be repaired,

including such additional adjacent surface area as is necessary to insure that the repaired area abuts sound pavement.

- 4.3 When a street is opened under a major opening permit, the entire improved width of the street shall be re-surfaced, including such additional adjacent surface area as is necessary to insure that the re-surfaced area abuts sound pavement.
- 4.4 When an unimproved right of way, or portion of a right of way, is opened under a major opening permit, the City Engineer may require that the disturbed portion of the right of way be improved with paving or sidewalks.
- 4.5 When the City Engineer determines that weather conditions do not permit proper re-surfacing of streets or the installation of curbs or sidewalks he may require the holder of the permit to post a bond, cash deposit or other form of security deemed acceptable by the Corporation Counsel, to secure the holder's obligation to perform the work when weather conditions permit.
- impose the cost of re-surfacing the street on a permit holder in view of plans by the City to re-construct said street within a definite time, the Council may require the permit holder to pay the City a sum of money equal to the estimated cost of re-surfacing.

  Any moneys paid pursuant to this section shall be paid into a capital account established for the reconstruction of said street and may be used only for such purpose.
