PRESENT: Mayor Bouyea, Aldermen Holland, O'Connell, Gioicsa, Demary, Behan and Tyreli.

By Alderman Holland; seconded by Alderman O'Connell LOCAL LAW NO. 15 OF 1942.

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Section 10, sub-division 2 of Chapter 269, of the Laws of 1902, entitled an act to incorporate the City of Plattsburgh, New York, in respect to the term of office of the appointive officers of the City of Plattsburgh, New York.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Platts-

That Sub-division 2 of Section 10 of the City Charter of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, be amended to read as follows:

Sub-division 2. The term of Office of the City Judge and of the Acting City Judge shall be two (2) years. Each member of the Board of Assessors shall be three (3) years. Each Member of the Board of Assessors snall be three (3) years. Each Member of the Board of Health shall be two (2) years. The term of office for the Health Officer shall be for four (4) years, for the City Poor Physician a term of two (2) years. Each member of the Board of Education five (5) years. Inspectors and Clerks of election one (1) year. Each member of the Municipal Civil Service Commission six years.

The office of the City Clerk, Corporation Counsel, City Chamberlain, Chief of Police and Chief Engineer of Fire shall, on and after September 1st, 1942, be declared Civil Service positions in the competitive class and the Civil Service rules of the City of Plattsburgh shall apply thereto. The office of the Commission of Public Welfare which has heretoforeexisted as a position in The office of the Commissionthe competitive class of the Municipal Civil Service, is hereby re-The terms of all other appointive offices as appointed by the Mayor shall be determined by the Mayor and the term of each subordinate appointed by said Boards shall be for such terms as such respective Boards may determine, except as otherwise provided by law; but the terms of office of the officers appointed by the Mayor except as provided by this Act, shall not continue beyond the term of the Mayor, or other officer or employee of the City whose term of office is not specifically stated herein, but whose appointment is specified in paragraph 1, Section 10 of the City Charter are deemed to be in Civil Service Status under the qualifications set forth in the Civil Service rules of the City of Plattsburgh, New York.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately.

On roll call, Aldermen Holland, O'Connell, Gioiosa, Demary, Behan and Tyrell, voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative.
