LOCAL LAW NO. 2 of 1939.

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 1925, ENTITLED "AN ACT TO SUPERSEDE SECTION 72 OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, NEW YORK, IN RELATION TO APPOINTMENT AND SALARIES OF THE OFFICERS AND MEMBERS OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, "AS AMENDED BY LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF 1927.

BE IT ENACTED by the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

Section 1. Section 72 of Local Law No. 2 of 1925 as amended by Local Law No. 1 of 1927, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 72. Appointment of Officers and Members of the Fire Department and the fixing of the salaries and compensation therefor. The Chief Engineer, Assistant Engineer and other paid Members of the Fire Department shall be appointed subject, as heretofore provided, to the approval of the Common Council.

The salary of the Chief Engineer of the Fire Department shall be \$1900.00 per annum.

The salary of the Assistant Engineer of the Fire Department shall be \$1660.00 per annum.

The salary of the regular paid Firemen on appointment shall be \$1400.00 per annum, and increased \$100.00 after the first year and \$100.00 after the second year; the salary of regular Firemen having served two years or more shall be \$1600.00 per annum. All salaries to be payable semi-monthly.

Section 2. This local law shall take effect February 1st,1939.

The foregoing local law certified to the Mayor this 4th day of February, 1939.

The above local law is hereby approved after public hearing held this 10th day of February, 1939.
