LOCAL LAW NO. 21 of 1942.

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Section 157 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902, in relation to the proceedings in case of failure to collect tax on warrant.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, that Section 157 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of the State of New York, for the Year 1902, entitled an act to incorporate the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as amended by Local Law No. 1 of 1941, be and the same is hereby further amended, and by such amendment to be superseded by the following:

Section 157. Proceedings in case of failure to collect tax on warrant.

On or before the first day of December next, after any tax, water charge or other assessment has been imposed upon any real estate in the City of Plattsburgh, New York, the Chamberlain shall make a transcript of such properties on which said tax, water charge or other assessment shall remain unpaid, the said transcript to contain a brief general description of the location, boundaries and estimated quantity of said parcel or parcels of land, the name of the owner or person to whom the same is assessed and the amount of taxes or assessments levied against said land, said transcript to be used in case of the sale of said land for the nonpayment of said taxes.

This act shall take effect on November 15th, 1942.

On roll call, Aldermen Holland, O'Connell, Giolosa, Demary, Behan and Tyrell voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative, CARRIED.
