LOCAL LAW NO. 260F 1949

ENTITLED AN ACT adding Section 45D to Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 and in this instance providing for the Notice of Assessments.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 45D is hereby added to Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902, the same to read as follows:

Section 45D. Notice of Assessments. Upon receiving any assessment roll with the warrant or authority to collect assessments other than those provided for in section one hundred fifty two, the City Chamberlain shall give notice in the official papers of the City of the receipt by him of such assessment roll and warrant, and that all persons named therein are required to pay their assessments at his office on or before the expiration of thirty days from the date of said first publication. During said thirty days every person, company, corporation or association may pay his, her or their taxes and assessments to said Chamberlain without fees. After the expiration of said thirty days fees shall be charged and collected as provided in section one hindred and fifty-three of this act.

SECTION 2. Laws Repealed. Section 63 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 and all acts amendatory thereof are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Time of Taking Effect. This act shall take effect after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Holland, LeClair, Villoni, Croteau, Ryan and Cardi voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative, CARRIED.
