LOCAL LAW NO. 3 OF 1966

A LOCAL LAW FIXING THE SALARY OF THE HOUSING INSPECTOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, CLINTON, COUNTY, NEW YORK, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. THE SALARY OF THE HOUSING INSPECTOR OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH SHALL BE THE SUM OF \$4909.00 ON APPOINTMENT, AND SHALL REACH THE SUM OF \$5610 IN FIVE (5) ANNUAL INCREMENTS.

SECTION 2. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT AFTER A PUBLIC HEARING AND APPROVAL BY THE MAYOR.
