## LOCAL LAW NO.320F 1949

ENTITLED AN ACT providing for the organization of the Department of Public Works of the City of Plattsburgh and eenacting new sections 52 and 53 the same being Title 5 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:-

Section 1. New sections 52 and 53, the same being Title 5 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 are hereby made a part of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902, said sections to read as follows:

Section 52. Organization. There shall continue in the City of Plattsburgh, a Department of Public Works. Said department shall have jurisdiction over all streets, highways, curbs, sidewalks, play grounds and all public lands and buildings and works except those public works which come under the jurisdiction of the Department of Water and Sewage and such public works as are otherwise placed under a different jurisdiction. The Superintendent of Public Works under the direction of the Common Council shall be the chief executive officer of said Department.

Section 53. Duties of the Superintendent of Public Works.

It shall be the duty of the Superintendent of Public Works to supervise generally all the activities of said department, to make or cause to be made such plans as are necessary for the opening, altering or widening of streets, lanes or alleys within said City of Plattsburgh. He shall keep accurate records of all employees who may be employed by said department, approve all payrolls which shall be submitted in accordance with the provisions of this act. In addition he shall under the direction of the Municipal Airport Commission perform such duties as may be assigned to him at the Plattsburgh Municipal Airport. He shall also perform such duties as may be assigned to him by the Park and Beach Commission of the City of Plattsburgh in relation to the property under their jurisdiction.

Section 2. Time of Taking Effect. This act shall take effect after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Holland, LeClair, Villoni, Croteau, Ryan and Cardi voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative, CARRIED.
