LOCAL LAW NO. 4 of 1939.

ENTITLED AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 1 OF LOCAL LAW NO. 3 OF 1928 AS ASSENDED BY LOCAL LAW NO. 4 OF 1937, PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN THE SALARY OF THE CITY CLERK PROS \$2500.00 PER ANNUE TO \$3,000.00 PER ANNUE, EFFECTIVE FEBRUARY 1ST, 1939.

BE IT EMACTED by the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, that Section 1 of Local Law No. 3 of 1925 as amended by Local Law No. 4 of 1937, be superseded by the following:

Section 1: The salary of the City Clerk be and hereby is fixed by the Common Council at \$5,000.00 per annum, of which not more than \$1320.00 shall be payable out of the General Fund and \$1660.00 shall be payable out of the Water Fund.

Section 2. That the additional duties imposed by Section 1 of Local Law No. 3 of 1928 shall be as follows:

That the City Clerk also be custodian of the City Hall and shall have supervision of the Janitor and Assistant Janitors, and in addition thereto that all duties prescribed by the City Charter and the law establishing the Fark & Beach Commission shall be in full force and effort as heretofore.

This act shall become effective February lat, 1939.

on roll call, Alderson Holland, O'Connell, Raymond, Light, Behan and McGready voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative.
