## LOCAL LAW NO 40 OF 1949

ENTITLED AN ACT amending Section 141 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

Section 1. Section 141 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 141. Deting City Judge, Designation of; Compersation. The Mayor shall designate in writing to be filed with the City Clerk, an attorney and counselor at-law residing within the City, who shall, only during sickness, absence from the city, disability or inability of the city judge to act, exercise in the process and stead of the City Judge all of the powers of said judge including jurisdiction in cases then pending before said City Judge. Such designation shall terminate at the expiration of the term of office of the then City Judge. The compensation of said acting City Judge shall be such as the Common Council shall determine, to be audited, allowed and paid by the Common Council upon presentation by such acting City Judge of a verified bill of items for his services.

Section 2. Time of Taking Effect. This act shall take effect after public and upon approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Holland, LeClair, Villoni, Croteau, Ryan and Cardi voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative, CARRIED.
