## LOCAL LAW NO. 5 of 1972

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING THE SPECIAL PROVISIONS OF SERVICE CLASSIFICATION NO. 2 OF LOCAL LAW NO. 3 OF 1972.

BE IT ENACTED By the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York:

SECTION I: The Special Provisions of Service Classification No. 2 of Local Law No. 3 of 1972 are hereby amended as follows:

All those customers, presently furnished water service by a water district, which itself is a water customer of the City of Plattsburgh, and who are connected to the sewer system of the City, shall be billed for said sewer service by applying the rates shown in this Service Classification to individually metered water consumptions for each customer of thewater district.

On large accounts, bills may be rendered monthly at the option of the Sewer Department. Where bills are rendered on a monthly basis, one-third of the above quantities shall be used in computing the charges for the various steps. The terms of payment for monthly billings are: Net - fifteen days after date of bill. Gross amount shall be due thereafter.

SECTION 2. LAWS REPEALED: All other schedules of sewer rates and regulations heretofore enacted and inconsistent in whole or in part with this Local Law are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: TIME OF TAKING EFFECT. This Local Law shall take effect with all bills rendered in the normal course of business on and after July 8th ,1972 and January 1, 1973, respectively, covering the use of sewer services, and after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Burke, Dame, Branon, Rennell, Griffin and Poitras voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative; CARRIED.
