### LOCAL LAW NO.6 OF 1964

ENTITLED AN ACT CLASSIFYING TITLES AND POSITIONS AND PROVIDING FOR THE MINIMUM AND MAXIMUM COMPENSATION, RATE OF ANNUAL INCREMENTS, AND TIME OF TAKING EFFECT OF SUCH INCREMENTS, FOR VARIOUS CITY PERSONNEL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, NEW YORK, AS FOLLOWS:

### SECTION 1. COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN CITY OFFICIALS

THE ANNUAL SALARY RATES OF THE FOLLOWING CITY OFFICIALS AND PERSONNEL SHALL BE THE AMOUNTS SHOWN BELOW:

THE SALARY OF THE ACTING CITY JUDGE SHALL BE AT THE RATE OF \$16.50 PER DAY EFFECTIVE AUGUST 13, 1964; \$17.50 PER DAY EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1965, FOR EACH DAY FOR WHICH HE SITS, BUT NOT TO EXCEED \$993.00 EFFECTIVE AUGUST 13, 1964, AND \$1053 EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1965, FOR ANY CALENDAR YEAR.

THE WAGE RATE FOR SCHOOL TRAFFIC OFFICERS SHALL BE \$1.25 PER HOUR AND \$25.60 FOR EACH 20-HOUR WEEK, BUT NOT TO EXCEED \$950.00 FOR EACH CALENDAR YEAR.

SUPERVISORS AND CONSTABLES SHALL BE ENTITLED TO RECEIVE THE SAME COMPENSATION FOR THEIR SERVICES AS CORRESPONDING OFFICERS IN THE TOWNS OF THE COUNTY OF CLINTON ARE ENTITLED TO RECEIVE FOR LIKE SERVICES.

INSPECTORS OF ELECTION AND OTHER ELECTION OFFICERS ENTITLED TO BE APPOINTED SHALL RECEIVE COMPENSATION WHICH IS HEREBY FIXED AS FOLLOWS: PRIMARY DAY - \$15.00; EACH REGISTRATION DAY - \$15.00; AND GENERAL ELECTION DAY - \$15.00; PARTY REPRESENTATIVES FOR ELECTIONS ENTITLED TO BE APPOINTED SHALL RECEIVE \$10.00 FOR ELECTION DAY; CUSTODIANS OF VOTING MACHINES SHALL RECEIVE \$100.00 FOR THEIR SERVICES FOR EACH CALENDAR YEAR.

MUNICIPAL LIGHTING DEPARTMENT: WAGES AND HOURS OF OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE MUNICIPAL LIGHTING DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH.

- A. THERE SHALL BE MAINTAINED A BASIC WORK DAY OF 8 HOURS AND A BASIC WORK WEEK OF 40 HOURS FOR ALL CLASSES OF EMPLOYEES WITH THE UNDERSTANDING THAT ANY OF THEM MAY BE REQUIRED TO WORK IN EXCESS OF 40 HOURS PER WEEK TO MEET EMERGENCIES, WHICH WORK IN EXCESS OF 40 HOURS WILL BE PAID FOR AT THE OVERTIME BASIS.
- B. FOR NON-SHIFT WORKERS, THE SCHEDULED WORK DAY SHALL BE BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 8 A.M. AND 5 P.M., EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE NOW NECESSARY OR WHERE CHANGED BY MUTUAL CONSENT, AND THE WORK WEEK SHALL BE MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY.
- C. SHIFT AND SCHEDULE WORKERS SHALL WORK IN ACCORDANCE WITH SCHEDULES POSTED FROM TIME TO TIME WHICH ARE ARRANGED AS FAR AS PRACTICABLE TO SUIT THE CONVENIENCE OF THE MAJORITY OF SUCH EMPLOYEES; SATURDAY, SUNDAY AND HOLIDAY WORK IS REQUIRED AS PART OF THE NORMAL SCHEDULE.
- D. OVERTIME SHALL BE PAID FOR AT THE RATE OF TIME AND ONE-HALF FOR ALL HOURS WORKED BEYOND THE REGULAR SCHEDULED EIGHT HOURS PER DAY OR FORTY HOURS PER WEEK EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED.
- E. OVERTIME SHALL BE SHARED EQUALLY IN EACH CLASS OF WORK IN SO FAR AS PRACTICABLE.
- F. NO EMPLOYEE SHALL BE LAID OFF ON A REGULAR SCHEDULED WORK DAY TO EQUALIZE OVERTIME WORK.
- G. SUNDAY WORK: NON-SHIFT EMPLOYEES SHALL BE PAID AT DOUBLE TIME FOR ALL HOURS WORKED. SCHEDULE AND SHIFT WORKERS SHALL BE PAID FOR AT STRAIGHT TIME. OFF SCHEDULE SHIFT WORK SHALL BE PAID FOR AT DOUBLE TIME. WHEN AN EMPLOYEE IS REGULARLY SCHEDULED TO WORK ON A SUNDAY, THE OFF-SCHEDULE SEVENTH CONSECUTIVE DAY OF HIS WORK WEEK SHALL BE PAID FOR AT DOUBLE TIME.
- H. THE FOLLOWING DAYS SHALL BE RECOGNIZED AS HOLIDAYS: NEW YEAR'S DAY, LINCOLN'S BIRTHDAY, WASHINGTON'S BIRTHDAY, MEMORIAL DAY, FOURTH OF JULY, LABOR DAY, COLUMBUS DAY, ELECTION DAY, ARMISTICE DAY, THANKSGIVING DAY AND CHRISTMAS DAY. THE FOLLOWING SHALL APPLY:
  - I. Non-shift employees shall have time off with regular straight time pay on holidays which fall upon their scheduled work days.
  - 2. If REQUIRED TO WORK, NON-SHIFT EMPLOYEES SHALL BE PAID IN ADDITION TO THE ABOVE, AT STRAIGHT TIME RATES FOR HOURS WORKED WITHIN THE REGULAR SCHEDULED HOURS AND AT THE DOUBLE TIME RATE FOR HOURS WORKED OUTSIDE OF THEIR REGULAR SCHEDULED HOURS.
  - 3. SHIFT AND SCHEDULED EMPLOYEES SHALL BE PAID AT DOUBLE TIME FOR ALL HOLIDAYS WORKED.
- I. PREMIUM PAY AT TEN CENTS PER HOUR WILL BE PAID TO THE 4-12 AND 12-8 SHIFTS FOR EMPLOYEES WHO SERVICE STREET LIGHTS, AND PREMIUM PAY AT SIX CENTS PER HOUR WILL BE PAID TO THE 4-12 AND 12-8 SHIFTS WORKED BY DIESEL PLANT OPERATORS. THIS PREMIUM RATE SHALL NOT BE PAID FOR WORK PERFORMED FOR WHICH THE EMPLOYEE IS PAID OVERTIME.

- J. SENIORITY RIGHTS SHALL BE RESPECTED REGARDING VACATION SCHEDULES.
- K. S.CK LEAVE OF TWELVE WORKING DAYS PER YEAR SHALL BE ALLOWED THE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE MUNICIPAL LIGHTING DEPARTMENT AFTER ONE YEAR OF CONTINUOUS SERVICE WITH SAID DEPARTMENT. SAID SICK LEAVE MAY BE ACCUMULATED AT THE RATE OF ONE DAY PER MONTH, UNTIL A TOTAL OF NINETY DAYS IS REACHED AND KEPT TO THE EMPLOYEE'S CREDIT FOR FUTURE SICK LEAVE WITH PAY.

ANY OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE WHO IS NECESSARILY ABSENT FROM DUTY BECAUSE OF SERIOUS ILLNESS OR DEATH IN HIS IMMEDIATE FAMILY, I.E., MOTHER, FATHER, SISTER, BROTHER, CHILDREN, HUSBAND OR WIFE, MOTHER-IN-LAW, FATHER-IN-LAW AND GRANDPARENTS, MAY WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE DEPARTMENT HEAD HAVING SUPERVISION OVER HIM BE GRANTED LEAVE WITH PAY AND THE TIME DEDUCTED FROM ACCUMULATED AND UNUSED SICK LEAVE TIME. THE OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE MUST NOTIFY AND HAVE THE APPROVAL OF HIS SUPERVISOR BEFORE SICK LEAVE CAN BE TAKEN. THE DEPARTMENT HEAD OR COMMON COUNCIL MAY REQUIRE A PHYSICIAN'S CERTIFICATE FOR ANY ABSENCE.

- L. AN EMPLOYEE CALLED FOR AND WHO PERFORMS JURY DUTY WILL BE COMPENSATED FOR THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN PAYMENT RECEIVED FOR SUCH JURY DUTY AND THE PAYMENT HE WOULD HAVE RECEIVED FOR STRAIGHT TIME HOURS HE WAS THEREBY REQUIRED TO LOSE FROM HIS REGULAR WORKING SCHEDULE.
- M. WHEN EMPLOYEES ARE CALLED OUT OR ORDERED TO WORK IN EMERGENCY (OFF SCHEDULE), THEY SHALL BE PAID THREE HOURS! STRAIGHT TIME AS A MINIMUM, BUT THE MAXIMUM SHALL BE GOVERNED BY THE APPLICABLE STRAIGHT TIME, OVERTIME, SUNDAY, OR HOLIDAY RATE, AS THE CASE MAY BE; TIME TO START WHEN THE CALL IS RECEIVED. WHEN AN EMPLOYEE IS REQUIRED TO REPORT AT HIS PLACE OF WORK ONE AND ONE-HALF HOURS OR LESS BEFORE HIS SCHEDULED OR RESCHEDULED TOUR OF DUTY BEGINS, HE SHALL BE PAID AT THE APPLICABLE OVERTIME RATE IN LIEU OF THE THREE HOURS STRAIGHT TIME MINIMUM.
- N. THE BASIC WAGE RATE OF EACH OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE SHALL BE INCREASED BY 2% UPON COMPLETION OF TEN, FIFTEEN AND TWENTY YEARS OF CONSECUTIVE EMPLOYMENT WITH THE MUNICIPAL LIGHTING DEPARTMENT; PROVIDED THAT SUCH LONGEVITY INCREMENTS SHALL COMMENCE ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE FISCAL YEAR FOLLOWING THE ONE DURING WHICH SUCH OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE SHALL HAVE COMPLETED TEN, FIFTEEN OR TWENTY CONSECUTIVE YEARS OF EMPLOYMENT WITH THE MUNICIPAL LIGHTING DEPARTMENT, AND SUCH LONGEVITY INCREMENTS SHALL BE PAYABLE IN CONSECUTIVE ORDER FOR TEN, FIFTEEN AND TWENTY YEARS OF CONSECUTIVE EMPLOYMENT WITH THE MUNICIPAL LIGHTING DEPARTMENT, AND FURTHER PROVIDED THAT THE INCREMENTS SHALL REMAIN EQUITABLE.

" THE HOLDERS OF THE FOLLOWING POSITIONS IN THE MUNICIPAL LIGHTING DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPHS A-G OF SECTION 2 OF THIS ACT, SHALL RECEIVE COMPENSATION AS FOLLOWS:

### SECTION 3. INCREMENTS

- I. Upon completion of successive years of City employment, the annual salary rate of each official, department head and employee listed in the salary and grade schedule of Section 2 shall be increased by one increment each fiscal year, in the respective amounts set forth in Section 2, until the maximum salary rates therein provided are attained.
  - A. Such salary rates resulting from SAID INCREMENTS SHALL BE EFFECTIVE BEGINNING ON THE ANNUAL ANNIVERSARY DATE OF EMPLOYMENT OR PROMOTION, EXCEPT
  - B. THAT SUCH EFFECTIVE DATE SHALL BE JANUARY I OF EACH YEAR FOR INCUMBENTS WHOSE PREVIOUS INCREMENT DATE WAS JANUARY I, 1962, AND WHO HAVE NOT SINCE BEEN PROMOTED OR OTHERWISE CHANGED IN STATUS, IN WHICH CASE THE ANNIVERSARY DATE AS PROVIDED ABOVE SHALL BE APPLICABLE.
- 2. THE ANNUAL SALARY RATE OF EACH OFFICIAL, DEPARTMENT HEAD AND EMPLOYEE LISTED IN THE SALARY AND GRADE SCHEDULE OF SECTION 2 SHALL BE INCREASED BY ONE INCREMENT, IN THE AMOUNTS ESTABLISHED IN SECTION 2 FOR THE RESPECTIVE POSITIONS, UPON COMPLETION OF TEN, FIFTEEN AND TWENTY YEARS OF CONSECUTIVE EMPLOYMENT BY THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, PROVIDED
  - A. THAT SUCH LONGEVITY INCREMENTS SHALL COMMENCE ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE FISCAL YEAR FOLLOWING THE ONE DURING WHICH SUCH PERSONNEL SHALL HAVE COMPLETED TEN, FIFTEEN OR TWENTY CONSECUTIVE YEARS OF EMPLOYMENT BY THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, AND PROVIDED FURTHER
  - B. THAT SUCH LONGEVITY INCREMENTS SHALL BE PAYABLE IN CONSECUTIVE ORDER FOR TEN, FIFTEEN AND TWENTY YEARS OF CONSECUTIVE EMPLOYMENT BY THE CITY, AND THAT NO ONE SHALL BE ENTITLED TO MORE THAN ONE LONGEVITY INCREMENT STEP DURING ANY FISCAL YEAR, AND PROVIDED FURTHER

- C. THAT REGARDLESS OF THE TOTAL NUMBER OF CONSECUTIVE YEARS OF EMPLOY-MENT BY THE CITY, PERSONNEL WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR SUCH LONGEVITY IN-CREMENTS UNTIL THE FIRST DAY OF THE FISCAL YEAR FOLLOWING THE ONE DURING WHICH THEIR ANNUAL SALARY RATE IS THE MAXIMUM PROVIDED FOR THEIR RESPECTIVE POSITIONS IN THIS ACT, EXCEPT
- D. THAT PERSONNEL WHO SHALL HAVE COMMENCED RECEIVING ONE OR MORE LONGEVITY INCREMENTS AND ARE SUBSEQUENTLY PROMOTED OR DEMOTED SHALL RECEIVE THE APPROPRIATE SALARY RATE OF THE NEW POSITION AS PROVIDED BY SECTION 4 OF THIS ACT, AND IN ADDITION SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE LONGEVITY INCREMENT OF SUCH NEW POSITION CORRESPONDING TO THAT PREVIOUSLY BEING RECEIVED; BUT ANY ADDITIONAL LONGEVITY INCREMENTS SHALL BE PAYABLE PURSUANT TO PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPHS A, B AND C OF THIS SUBDIVISION.

## SECTION 4. PROMOTIONS, DEMOTIONS, TRANSFERS

- I. PERSONNEL PROMOTED SHALL RECEIVE THAT SALARY IN THE RANGE PRESCRIBED FOR THE POSITION TO WHICH HE OR SHE IS PROMOTED WHICH IS ONE INCREMENT OF THE NEW SALARY GRADE HIGHER THAN THE SALARY RATE HE OR SHE PREVIOUSLY WAS RECEIVING. FOR THOSE PERSONNEL RECEIVING LONGEVITY INCREMENTS, THE MAXIMUM SALARY WITHOUT LONGEVITY OF THE POSITION TITLE PREVIOUSLY HELD SHALL BE USED IN DETERMINING THE APPLICABLE SALARY RATE FOR THE PROMOTION. THEREUPON, ELIGIBILITY FOR LONGEVITY PAY SHALL BE COVERED BY THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 3 OF THIS ACT.
- 2. PERSONNEL DEMOTED SHALL RECEIVE THAT SALARY IN THE LOWER CLASSIFICATION CORRESPONDING TO THE INCREMENT STEP PREVIOUSLY RECEIVED IN THE HIGHER POSITION. ELIGIBILITY FOR LONGEVITY SHALL BE GOVERNED BY THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 3 OF THIS ACT.
- 3. PERSONNEL TRANSFERRED FROM ONE DEPARTMENT OR UNIT TO ANOTHER AND CONTINUING IN THE SAME POSITION TITLE SHALL RECEIVE THE SAME BALARY GRADE.

## SECTION 5. PART-TIME AND TEMPORARY EMPLOYMENT

THE COMMON COUNCIL, OR ANY OTHER OFFICER WHO MAY BE SO AUTHORIZED OR EM-POWERED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL, MAY EMPLOY PERSONS ON A PART-TIME OR TEMPORARY BASIS TO PERFORM ANY OF THE DUTIES OF THE POSITIONS LISTED IN THIS ACT.

### SECTION 6. LEGAL HOLIDAYS

CITY EMPLOYEES EMPLOYED ON AN HOURLY BASIS WHO ARE REQUIRED TO WORK ON A DAY DESIGNATED FOR THE OBSERVANCE OF A LEGAL HOLIDAY, SATURDAYS AND SUNDAYS EXCEPTED, SHALL, IN ADDITION TO A DAY'S WAGES FOR SUCH HOLIDAY, BE ENTITLED TO COMPENSATION FOR THE NUMBER OF HOURS ACTUALLY WORKED AT THEIR USUAL HOURLY RATE AS ESTABLISHED HEREIN.

### SECTION 7. Supersession

PROVISIONS OF ALL ACTS INCONSISTENT WITH THIS ACT ARE HEREBY SUPERSEDED.

#### SECTION 8. TIME OF TAKING EFFECT.

This Act shall be in effect on and after August 13, 1964, after Public Hearing and approval by the Mayor.
