LOCAL LAW NO. 7 OF 1948.

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Section 31 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 "Entitled An Act to incorporate the City of Plattsburgh" and in this instance authorizing the employment of clerical help for said Board of Assessors.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

SECTION I. Section 31 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 entitled an act to incorporate the City of Plattsburgh, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 31. The City Assessors. The city assessors shall perform all the duties required of them by this act in relation to the assessment of property in said city as well as for the purpose of imposing taxes levied by the Board of Supervisors of Clinton County as those levied by the Common Council of said city and to that end they shall perform all the duties and possess all the power and authority of town assessors except as modified by this act. They are hereby authorized to employ such clerical help as may be necessary to perform the duties within the limitations of the budget as prescribed by the Common Council of the City.

SECTION II. This act shall take effect after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.
