LOCAL LAW NO. . 8 OF 1944.

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Section 11 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 as last amended by Local Law No. 5 of 1943 and Local Law No. 2 of 1944 with respect to the per annum salary paid each regular Patrolman and Fireman serving by appointment and providing for a ten (10%) per cent increase in basic salary effective January 1, 1944, and advancing to January 1, 1944 the increment of \$100.00 to which the Police Sergeants and Assistant Chief Engineer of the Fire Department employed on January 1,1944 will have been entitled to receive on September 1, 1944.

BE IT ENACTED by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, that Section 11 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 as last amended by Local Law No. 5 of 1943 and Local Law No. 2 of 1944 be further amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1. The salary of the Chief of Police or the Acting Chief of Police shall be \$2,500.00 per annum, payable out of the Police Fund. The salary of the Police Sergeants shall be \$1,900.00 per annum upon appointment, with an increase of \$100.00 per annum until the maximum of \$2,100.00 is reached, except that the Police Sergeants entitled to receive the increment of \$100.00 due September 1,1944 shall receive such increment as of January 1,1944. The salary of each regular patrolman, with respect to his individual years in service, shall be as follows: FIRST YEAR — \$1,760.00; SECOND YEAR — \$1,670.00; THIRD AND SUBSEQUENT YEARS — \$1,980.00.

SECTION 2. The annual salary of the Assistant Chief E ngineer of the Fire Department, upon appointment, shall be the sum of \$1,900. OO with an increase at the rate of \$100.00 per annum until the sum of \$2,100.00 per annum is reached, except that the Assistant Chief Engineer of the Fire Department entitled to receive the increment of \$100. OO on September 1, 1944, shall receive such increment as of January 1, 1944.

SECTION 3. The salary of each regular fireman, with respect to his individual years in service, shall be as follows: FIRST YEAR _ \$1,760.00; SECOND YEAR _ \$1,870.00; THIRD AND SUBSEQUENT YEARS _ \$1,980.00.

SECTION 4. The amount of money representing the increments provided for in Section No. 1, No. 2 and No. 3 of this Act shall, during the year 1944, be payable as follows: One Thousand(\$1,000.00) dollars out of the Fire Fund, which sum may be raised pursuant to Law, and the balance out of unestimated revenues pursuant to resolutions of the Common Council, following certification by the City Chamberlain, from time to time, to the effect that the necessary amount is accumulated and available for such expenditures. Subsuquent to 1944 the entire amount of said salaries shall be included in the Police and Fire budgets and shall be payable out of the Police and Fire Funds, respectively.

The foregoing Local Law shall take effect January 1, 1944 after Public Hearing and approval by the Mayor.
