LOCAL LAW NO. 8 OF 1949

ENTITLED AN ACT amending Section 146 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 in this instance substituting the words "Commissioners of Assessment and Taxation" for the Word "Assessors".

BE IT ENACTED BY the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

Section 1. Section 146 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902 is hereby amended to read as follows:

of Assessment and Taxation shall in each year prepare an assessment roll of the persons and property taxable within the city, in the same manner and form as is required by law for the preparation of town assessment-rolls, except as modified by this act. In the assessment of any land in said city for any purpose, it shall be sufficient to state the name of one of the owners or occupants of said land, and also the street and number of any building thereon; but if the land be vacant or the building thereon not numbered, then the name of the street on which it fronts shall be given. In case no inhabited building is on the land, the owner may be designated as unknown. No error in the name of the owner or occupant shall invalidate the assessment. Except as herein provided, only one assessment shall be made in each year for all the taxes levied within the city during that year.

Section 2. Time of Taking Effect. This act shall take effect after public hearing and approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Holland, LeClair, Villoni, Croteau, Ryan and Cardi voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative, CARRIED.
