LOCAL LAW NO. 8 OF 1966

A LOCAL LAW AUTHORIZING THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH TO FIX OFFICE HOURS FOR THE OFFICE OF THE MAYOR AND VARIOUS CITY DEPARTMENTS BY RESOLUTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, NEW YORK AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 20 OF THE GENERAL CITY LAW AND IRRESPECTIVE OF ANY OTHER LEGISLATION, THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLATTSBURGH, MAY, BY RESOLUTION, FIX OFFICE HOURS FOR THE OFFICE OF THE MAYOR AND VARIOUS CITY DEPARTMENTS.

SECTION 2: THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT AFTER PUBLIC HEARING AND APPROVAL BY THE MAYOR.
