LOCAL LAW NO. 9 OF 1947.

ENTITLED AN ACT to amend Section 11, Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902, as amended by various local laws to date, in this instance providing for the minimum and maximum compensation, rate of increase and time of taking effect of such increase, for the City Clerk of the City of Plattsburgh, New York.

Be it enacted by the Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 11 of Chapter 269 of the Laws of 1902, as amended by Local Law No. 1 of 1947, is hereby amended with respect to the minimum and maximum compensation, rate of increase and time of taking effect of such increase, for the position of City Clerk of the City of Plattsburgh, New York, to read as follows:

The salary of the City Clerk upon appointment, shall be \$3,400.00 per year, the same to be increased at the rate of \$200.00 per year until the maximum salary of \$4,500.00 is reached, provided, however, that the present incumbent in the Office of the City Clerk shall receive the maximum compensation of \$4,500.00 per year payable as follows: 40% payable out of the General Fund, 40% payable out of the Water Fund, 12% payable out of the Municipal Lighting Department Revenues, and 5% payable out of the Sewer Operation and Maintenance Fund.

SECTION 2. The foregoing Local Law shall take effect November 16,1947, and after Public Hearing and upon approval by the Mayor.

On roll call, Aldermen Gervais, LeClair, Giolosa, Demary and Cardi voted in the affirmative; no one in the negative (Alderman Ryan being absent), CARRIED.

The foregoing Local Law No. 9 of 1947, is hereby certified to the Mayor this 12th day of November, 1947.
